Text extracted Preaching Pastor Balmir Rodrigues da Cunha, for sister Graça Moura.

I greet the Church with the Peace of the Lord Jesus!

We are servants of the Lord, we await the coming of the Lord, until the Lord come, we have to work for the Kingdom of God and care for our brothers, in what God gives us as a legacy and obligation.

I have been beloved Church, continually praying for you! You are the legacy that God has placed in my hands to take care! God has given me the opportunity to intercede for each one; He puts me on the responsibility as pastor, to take care of you, **brother**, **sister!**

We have a momentary study that very special someone speech that changed by grace, mercy, the size and the Work of God.

Being a servant is something that today, beloved Church, is very secondary, secondary unfortunately, because many consider themselves servants; and be a servant is not a simple thing! It is a serious, very serious thing!

Psalms 146.5: "Blessed is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the Lord his God."

Praise and glory of God is an essential thing! It has everything to do with our lives, what we stand for, what we are.

In the secular field we are dedicated to our business sometimes because after we have an income, a salary and even the danger of being laid off, dismissed.

Often some become servants and not realize that it can also lose principal: the heavenly glory!

And even more, what is worse, your stay on earth can be compromised! It is interesting to note that the ordinance, obligation, responsibility in the eyes of some, is more in purpose of a worker, a minister, than the believer.

Ah! I'm not here to be caregiver !!!

Not so! Even the children who are cared for by their parents are taught to be caregivers! We can observe that children, older children care for younger as his parents!

In verse in reference because it speaks of Jacob? Because until then he was plaintiff. You're a postulant !!!

It is as if the Word said, "Blessed is he who follows the principles of someone who postulates"!

I Peter 3:14: ". But if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you are blessed and be not afraid of them, neither be troubled."

Matthew 5:11: "Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you and persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me."

James 1:12: "Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him."

Every believer, a servant of God who has this path, this journey; this ride that is ready! In his stay, he is blessed!

The Bible says that he who assumes and assimilates the precepts of the Lord are a royal priesthood. "You are priests of God" !!!

This will assimilate that when so stand before the Father to feel how they felt the priests, but it is necessary to prepare the "guise"! Because there is disagreement, difference, is not getting to the Lord.

Why the word Sanctification is very literal. "Without holiness it is impossible to see, come to God." It's impossible!!!!!

The structure of the believer, therefore, is crucial. Brother! sister! you have read the Word of God? Do You know the Word of God? You know you have some lines there? Some strong things, as some say ...

This structure being referred to are trials to be approved, it is renunciation, humiliation. full waiver same!

Jacob was chosen because God spoke to God. Jacob had a discipline that few, certainly would! When the believer is replaced intimacy with God truly, he is impressed: "My God I did not understand that it is so nice to have intimacy, talk, see God speak to us"!

God speaks in many ways, by revelation in the Word, in praise, dreams. God wants to speak and we want to hear for sure, and He will! for the glory Himself!!

Jacob could see that it takes to actually get closer to God, be prepared, structured to enter the place "Holy of Holies". He was humiliated for 20 years for a man, Laban, and during the journey he had when he lived with Laban, the Lord was with him at all times!

Brothers! sisters! do you have the notion of trial of Jacob? God tests us and often we do not accept! Imagine the situation of Jacob!

Even in all circumstances in which Jacob has, everything he laid his hands had turned out!

Jacob was a man after God's heart.

After his departure from the land of Laban he had to go through the Val Jabbok and also reconnect with his brother Esau.

How many believers going through struggles and do not realize that God wants to be in control! Jacob knew that, so he did not despair! He wrestled with the Angel of the Lord, had its name changed from Jacob to Israel (chosen people, prepared, separated to serve the living God) because you have striven with God and with men, and hast prevailed.

At that time it was God speaking to us: called no more "that evangelical" but you now have a name, Israelite!!

The believer who takes this identity it is as much as Jacob. You have that power in the hands valiantly.

Every believer who has an achievement he has in front of the Val Jabbok! "We all how many times have we passed the Val Jabbok!

147 years of Jacob were indescribable experience! There were many battles, terrible trials, but the victory was fantastic! Serves as an example for all who obey, they renounce, humiliate, persevere!

Isaiah 41. 8-15: "But thou, Israel, my servant, you Jacob, whom I have chosen, seed of Abraham my friend, you [ie close] whom I took from the ends of the earth and called from the your most excellent and said unto thee, thou art my servant, I have chosen thee and not cast you, do not fear, for I am with thee: be not dismayed, for I am your God, I'll stress, and help you, and I keep to the right hand of my righteousness Here are ashamed and confounded that will be all those who were incensed against thee. make will be nothing, and those who trive with thee shall perish. Seek them ace, and will not find; and that contended with thee will be nothing, and as a thing of nothing, that war against you. For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help you. Fear not, O Jacob bug, ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel. Behold, I have prepared for you new rail, which has sharp teeth; the mounts tread and coinshills; and shalt make the hills as chaff. "

These verses are a prophecy of God that is worth up to today.

For this we have to know God! Jacob knew! you know?

I glorify the Lord for the knowledge that I have had so far, and I want to know more!

Psalm 65.4: "Blessed is he whom thou choosest, [who have intimacy with God] and bring near to you, [will only come if conditions] that he may dwell in thy courts [sanctuary] we will be fed up [those who took] the goodness of your house and the holy temple "[tabernacle, the holy place of the Saints].

Genesis chapter 17 tells of Abraham who was intimate with God; sanctification is the principle of the link of this intimacy in question.

Luke chapter 12 speaks of Moses who spoke "mouth to mouth" with God, because it was intimate.

Believer who has intimacy with God learns to conquer the beatitudes much more easily, even if they are painful, because without these questions is impossible to reach this glorious index.

Psalms 34.15: "The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, [close] and his ears are open unto their cry" [intimate heart with God].

Heroes of the Bible were intimate with God and persevering thus victorious!

Hebrews 11:33: "Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions."

Brothers, how many Goliath felled in your life, in my life!

I Peter 3:17: "For it is better to suffer for doing good (if so God will want it), than doing evil."

The more God, less enemy!

Do not fear what you have to go! Fear not those who look at you with a difference!

Hebrews 10:36: "For you have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, you might receive the promise."

"I have seen thy cry. I have seen your postulant. know of your need. Assimilates the purpose of your God and I will be with you" says the Lord.

"Come near to God and he will come to you, but Purge your hearts" (James 4.8). Take what God does not agree this is the formula: Consecration.

The Val Jabbok can be crossed if you like Jacob, who became Israel, as you are now. You are more than a conqueror in what truly is upon you!
